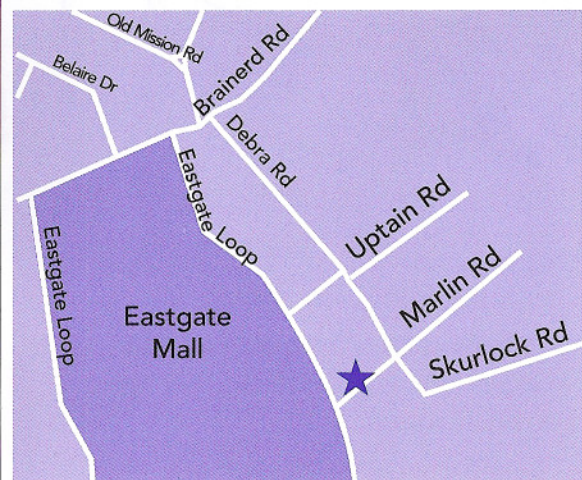


Location

To understand and serve the health and wellness needs of the medically underserved in our community by providing quality, compassionate and personalized care in a faith-based caring environment.

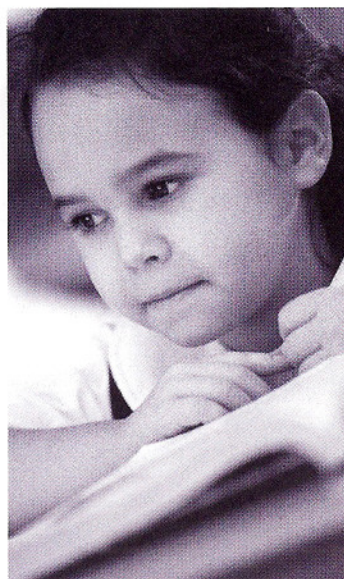

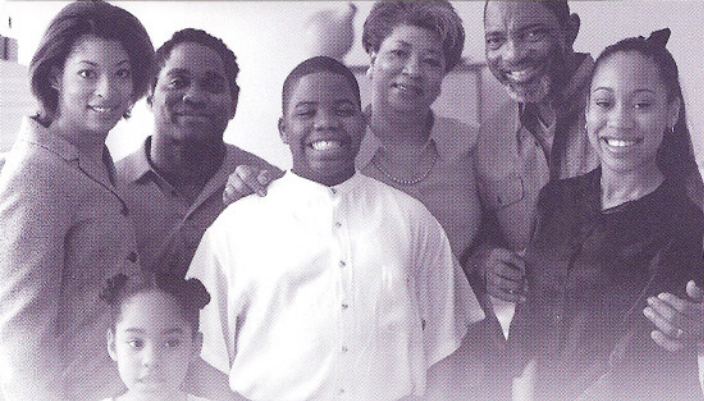

If the answer is yes, Volunteers in Medicine-Chattanooga may be able to help.

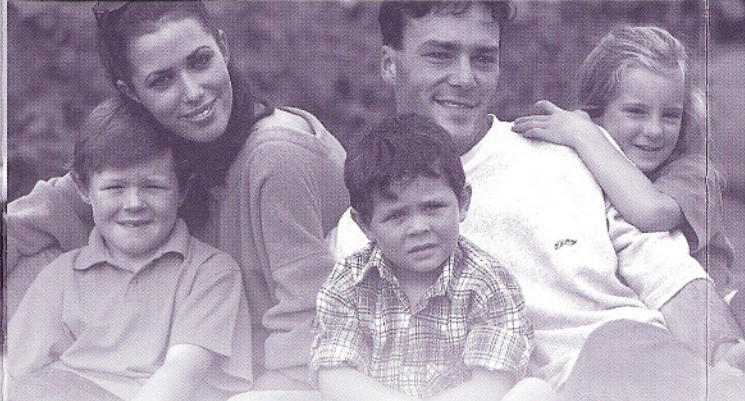
Eligibility

How to know if you qualify

You may be eligible to receive healthcare at no charge at Volunteers in Medicine-Chattanooga (called the VIM Clinic) if you:

- Have been a resident of Hamilton County at least 90 days, and
- Are not eligible for a government program (including Medicare and TennCareSM) and do not have private insurance, and
- Have an annual household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level:
 - Single-person..... \$21,660 or less
 - Household of two..... \$29,140 or less
 - Household of three..... \$36,620 or less
 - Household of four \$44,100 or less
 - Household of five \$51,580 or less

Clinic Services

What kind of care is offered?

- Primary and preventive care
- Care for some chronic and long-term medical conditions
- Referrals for specialty care
- Health education and nutrition management programs
- Prescription drugs for VIM Clinic patients

Services are provided by community volunteers, including doctors, nurses, dentists, hygienists, medical assistants, social service professionals and others. VIM Clinic services may change from time to time based on the availability of volunteers.

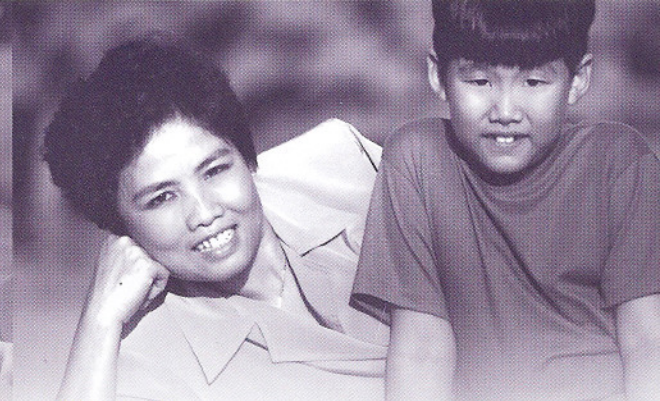

How to obtain free care

When you call the VIM Clinic, a counselor will walk you through the eligibility process. If you meet the requirements, you will be given an appointment.

The counselor will tell you what documents to bring to your appointment. When you arrive at the clinic, your documents will be reviewed to verify your eligibility.

A medical volunteer will treat eligible patients in a private exam room.



Clinic Hours

When is the VIM Clinic open?

Emergency Care

What if I need immediate help?

The VIM Clinic does not provide emergency care. In case of emergency, call 911 or go directly to the nearest emergency room.

There is no charge for services, tests or medications provided by the VIM Clinic.

If you need special attention that cannot be provided at the VIM Clinic, we will help you find the medical care you need, but cannot guarantee it will be provided free of charge.

The VIM Clinic cannot accept insurance.
